

HOLSTER 3 \$750

This hand tooled holster, belt and buckle were made for now deceased and renowned Canon City style contemporary bit and spur maker JACK FERGUSON in 1955 at the Colorado State Prison in Canon City Colorado by his brother Charles W. Ferguson who was inmate no. 28212. Jack's initials appear on the buckle as well as the holster. The buckle is engraved in the Canon City style and the extensive floral tooling of the leather is impressive. The belt measures 36" long to the buckle and is 3 1/2" wide. The holster measures 9 1/2" long top to bottom and the belt buckle is just over 3" wide. Jack was a personal friend, and we acquired this holster set directly from him over 25 years ago.
