We commissioned these incredible double mounted JACK FERGUSON CANON CITY PRISON SLIPPER spurs from Jack, now deceased, over 20 years ago, asking him to make the best pair he had ever or would ever make. We waited nine months to get this substantial and heavy pair of spurs. The incredibly fine workmanship is a superior example of Jack's work as he represented the bit and spur origin of the Colorado State Prison, of which he co-authored the definitive book with Patrice Maul. The spurs measure 7 3/8" long, 3 1/8" across inside the heel bands, and the heel bands are 15/16" wide. The scalloped rowels measure 2 1/4" across. The fine floral tooled two piece roller buckle straps perfectly compliment the spurs.
