

SPURS 79 CANON CITY PRISON DOUBLE MOUNTED MCKINNEY ATTRIBUTED SPURS AND STRAPS \$3,150

These incredibly well made smaller pair of CANON CITY PRISON spurs we purchased from the LEE JACOBS collection, and they were inspected by the late Jack Ferguson and attributed to E.H. MCKINNEY, although not marked. Jack, the co-author of the definitive book Colorado Prison Spurs & The Men Who Made Them, had no doubt as to their origin. The spurs measure 5" long, 2 3/4" across inside the heel bands, and the heel bands are 1/2" wide. The 10 point rowels measure 1 3/8" across. The fine straps are perfect for the spurs with a large 3/4" spot surrounded by smaller spots and even more yet smaller spots along the strap design.
