Enormous and incredible Porquier Beau dish which we purchased over 25 years ago in Paris, France from a renown expert's private collection. This is a lifetime find and one of the most rare and exquisite pieces we have seen. We call it MOAB, Mother Of All Bent Pieces, and it won't disappoint. The detailed hand painted scene of Briton musicians and people dancing, along with the Quimper coat of arms at the top, are surrounded by the large curls and folds that make this piece one of a kind. Measures 16 ¼" long, 13 ¼" wide and 2" high. Flat on the bottom, it is marked with the earliest PB (Porquier Beau) mark and it is in perfect condition. It dates from 1875. This piece is an absolute treasure.
