

SPURS 62 LARGE C1900 INLAID DOUBLE MOUNTED SONORAN SPURS WITH DOMED CONCHO STRAPS \$1,650

We purchased these incredibly fine large C1900 INLAID DOUBLE MOUNTED SONORAN spurs at Brian Lebel's Old West Auction at Cody, Wyoming in 2000. They are the real deal with inlaid silver on both heel bands, including the top and bottom edges, as well as all around the detailed shanks, the spurs also have domes along one heel band. These spurs are substantial in size and quite heavy. They measure 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ " long, 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " across inside the heel bands, and the heel bands are $\frac{7}{8}$ " across on the dome side. The 8 point rowels measure 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ " across. The straps, with their 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " dome sterling silver conchos are perfect for the spurs and appear to have been with them since the spurs were made over 120 years ago. This is a rare pair of such detailed and all original spurs from the era in such fabulous condition.
