We have owned this incredible pair of CANON CITY PRISON spurs for nearly 30 years. We knew they were special when we acquired them, as the workmanship is among the best to ever come out of the shop at the prison. Upon inspection by the late Jack Ferguson, who co-authored the definitive book on Canon City Prison spurs, he declared that, although not marked, they were undoubtedly made by JOHN COX, as the quality and detail are unmistakable. This is an all original, huge and heavy pair of spurs, measuring 7 ½" long, the heel bands are 3 3/8" across inside, and the 21 point rowels measure 2 ½" across. The floral tooled two-piece straps and their Canon City Prison made buckle sets were also prison made and are perfect for this epic pair of spurs.
