Scope and Content

Box 1 of the Vassar-Booth Collection consists of legal and financial documents of the Vassar and Booth families of Poughkeepsie, NY. The box houses several legal documents following the death of Booth and Vassar family members, including wills, payments and matters of estate following the death of Oliver Booth, Lydia Booth, Lucia Booth, Edwin Vassar Booth, and Matthew Vassar Jr. There is personal correspondence within the Booth Family and correspondence between Matthew Vassar and Oliver Booth, along with Matthew Vassar Sr.'s Pale Ale recipe.

Box 2 of the Vassar-Booth Collection contains 9 hardcover notebooks, all attributed to the Women's City Missionary Society (WCMS), formerly known as the Women's Union Bible and

Tract Society or the Female Union Bible Society of Poughkeepsie. These are titled as minute-books, detailing the constitution of the organization, demographic information about members, and annual meeting notes spanning from 1840 to 1919. It is noted in the minutes that both Mrs. Jewett and Mrs. Vassar were members.

Historical Note

Box 1

Matthew Vassar Sr. (1792-1868) was a prominent entrepreneur in the development of Poughkeepsie. He immigrated with his family from Norfolk, England, in 1796, settling near Wappinger's Creek until 1801, when the family moved into Poughkeepsie's center. In early adulthood, Matthew Vassar Sr. worked in a brewery founded by his father, James Vassar, and uncle, Thomas Vassar, who were credited with planting the first acre of barley in Dutchess County in 1799. The brewery found moderate success from 1801 to 1811, when it burned down. Within the same year, Matthew Vassar Sr. founded M. Vassar and Co., housed in a property owned by George Booth, Vassar's brother-in-law married to sister Maria.

Matthew Vassar Sr. became involved in multiple businesses and organizations across Poughkeepsie; an oyster saloon in the Kings County Courthouse, est. 1812, appointment as a Poughkeepsie village trustee in 1819, participation in Fire Company #3 of Poughkeepsie in 1823, establishment of both the Poughkeepsie Savings Bank in 1831 and Poughkeepsie Whaling Company in 1835, the ownership of a brickyard in 1837, presidency of the Poughkeepsie Lyceum of Literature, Science, and Mechanic Arts from 1838 to 1853, and the development of a Poughkeepsie Railroad in 1842.

M. Vassar and Co. transferred partnership from Englishman Thomas Purser to J. M. N. Conklin, Jr. in 1815 until 1829. In 1832, Vassar entered a partnership with his nephews, Matthew Vassar Jr. and John Guy Jr., resulting in the establishment of a newly constructed waterfront brewery in 1836. By 1836, M. Vassar and Co. had four branches; the two locations in Poughkeepsie, a location in Albany, and a location in New York City.

Matthew Vassar Jr. and John Guy Jr. carried Matthew Vassar's entrepreneurial spirit, both giving money in their wills for the creation of a hospital in Poughkeepsie's city. After their deaths, Irene Beech Vassar, Oliver H. Booth (1823-1896), and James H. Week worked to establish the hospital, joining the Board of Trustees. Vassar Brother's Hospital opened on April 11, 1887. A nephew of Matthew Vassar and brother to Lydia Booth, Oliver H. Booth held the position of chief of Poughkeepsie's 7th ward fire department from 1851 to 1854, and the founder of the O.H. Booth Hose Co. est. 1852.

Matthew Vassar Sr.'s niece, Lydia Booth, and Milo P. Jewett, founder of the Judson Female Institute in Alabama, worked to convince Matthew Vassar of the merits of women's education,

greatly influencing him in his 1861 decision to found Vassar Female College (referred to as Vassar College since 1867) in Poughkeepsie. Vassar Female College accepted its first students in 1865, and continues to offer co-ed liberal arts education.

Box 2

The Women's City Missionary Society was a philanthropic women's group organized by Dutchess County Women with a focus on poverty alleviation and Christian charity. First known as the Female Union Bible Society, the group's first meeting was on October 14, 1840, originally acting as an auxiliary group to the Bible Society of Dutchess County. In the words of the first constitution of the organization, "the object of this society shall be, through the agency of the Bible Society of Dutchess County, to aid in supplying the destitute heathen with the Bible."

The Society sponsored and supported the creation of the Industrial School in a local New York Presbyterian Church in 1863, which employed four teachers and taught upwards of thirty children lessons in biblical scripture. The school was unable to be sustained after 1867, the same year the Society changed its name to the Female Union Bible and Tract Society. The Society continued to expand in their charitable endeavors, organizing clothing drives and visits to the sick, despite declining membership in the mid to late 1800s. In an entry from the Secretary's Report, 1876, it is estimated that members of the Female Union Bible and Tract Society had visited 1,300 families monthly. During this period, members of the Society would distribute bibles and *The American Messenger*, published by the American Tract Society. Their documented charitable actions continued until 1926.

Provenance

The collection was purchased by the Dutchess County Historical Society from Bill Rinaldi Auctions in the Summer of 1982. This collection represents three separate items sold at the same auction. It is unknown if the material was taken from the same context prior to the sale. In 1986, the pale ale recipe (1982.0069) was included in the exhibition "Vassar College and its Eight Presidents 1861-1986" which was displayed at the Frederick Ferris Thompson Memorial Library.
