Historical Note

The Luyster family owned a chunk of land between East Fishkill and Hopewell Junction. Alfred Bonney (1857-1950) was involved in politics, at both a state and county level. His father was a member of the New York Supreme Court, and Alfred himself was elected to the state assembly in 1882.
