Scope and Content

The collection consists of 15 daybooks, 5 account books, 1 unidentified index and one partnership record.

Historical Note

The materials were created by the Losee family, which included E.K. Losee, H. Losee, & J.E. Losee. J.E. Losee had a partnership with Dr. Alexander R. Gray of Hyde Park. Both E.K. and H. Losee were members of the Delta Phi fraternity and lived in Upper Red Hook, New York. E.K. Losee graduated from Rutgers in 1887 as a member of the Philoclean Society and became a doctor noted for treating seasickness. His mother-in-law, Mrs. James Lamb died on July 1st, 1903 in Long Beach, California and was buried in Los Angeles, California.
