- ① Greek army (not a miniature)
Spanish? Puritan? priest/father/minister } probably not a miniature
- ② 3 Japanese dolls in grey-red-very colorful w/beard
- ③ 5 small child print dress & bonnet frontier
2 bearded men
2 hirsute men in aprons
1 fellow in buckskins
1 ugly broad in ~~satén~~ copper color satén dress

left hand from top

- ① Piruvian lady w/babe (not a miniature)
2 Spanish (?) couple figures - maybe Italian
- ② what looks like very primitively made so. amer. rid on horse or? wrapped yarn
Viking warrior
- ③ Doctor? nurse - child w/maraboutie - young man (interu?)
- ④ 4 man in blue jacket - bare feet on ^{white} wicker chair - wicker table
pink & blond chickie in harem dress on cushion
sweatered mustachoid man on natural wicker chair
w/feet on wicker foot stool

Bottom shelf surrounding Francis' Turkey Wagon

from left

- ① young red-haired man in brown jacket
- ② seated on wagon baldish man in red vest & black pants
- ③ child in blue in front of wagon

- to the right of the wagon 6" dolls -

- 1 & 2 look like husband & wife in plantation (civil war) ^{straw hat} style dress
- 3 is Victorian lady ^{large} feathered hat shades of orchid black trim
- 4 lady in navy dress with Gibson girl sleeves (?) ^{white} lace bodice
- 5 older lady (looking like Victoria somewhat) in black mourning
- 6 older graying black (servant) I am assuming
