Dear Uncle

I received your letter with the check for a hundred dollars in due time. and also one ~~bag~~ of orchard grass seed

This will be presented to you by B. Skipper who thinks that he cannot live with the Jerseymen they don't like a black man he says. and the other day he took some offence at some foolish speech of one of my men.

Soon after Polly got sick and she wont have our country doctor for some foolish reason. and Margaret says she is glad she is going. Bob has received all his pay except ...45 dollars which is more than the amount in my hands. and you oblige me by paying hime some time or other

before breakfast in haste
