

Lisbon Farm Sep 24th 1855

Dear cousin

Inclosed you will find a letter directed to Fredrick Kahb& inclosed in that is one for J. Columbus Fenwick. trusting in your former kindness. I have sent them to you that they may be properly started on there way.

The letter you spoke of having written to me I found at home when I arrived. the impossibility of paying you that interest untill I get some of my crop in market without I should have a note in bank discounted is apparrent. and as that is out of my way way of doing. I should not know how to proceed to get an indorser. but if it is your wish that it should be paid at once. say so and I will use my best endeavours to do so. If I have done wrong in this thing. I am truly sorry for it. & should take your reprimand as that of a true friend.
