- (1) Musicians were paid \$6.20 per hour in 2004, a \$.30 drop. Home practice time or set up time by the musicians is not compensated. The band has a set nucleus of paid musicians. Rained out concerts are less likely because the Centerpoint Mall is generally able to provide an indoor site. Costs include 50 paid musicians for 31 hours each. 2005 proposed rate: \$6.50/hr.
- (2) The Band insures its music and has been given space (at no charge) at the White library to store it.
- (3) SPASH, UWSP, and others continue to provide practice space for the Band at no charge. Estimated value: \$1000.00.
- (4) By transferring a small amount of patron gifts and ad revenues each year, the City Band hopes to encourage greater giving by the general public through an established fund. Several patrons made direct contributions to the Fund in year 2004. The 6/30/04 Community Foundation City Band Endowment Fund balance was \$9182.65. Earnings will be available when the Fund balance reaches \$10,000.
