

#### **FANFARE FACTS**

The quartet has been active in barbershopping since February of 1965. In the summer of 1965 they appeared in the "Music Under the Stars" presentation of The Music Man in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. In November of 1965 they competed for and won the L.O.L. District Championship in Appleton, Wisconsin; and the following May were among four winners selected to represent the L.O.L. District at the Chicago convention where they wound up quarter finalists.

The Fanfares disbanded in May of 1967 when one member left for job training in New York and formed again in February of 1968 with a new baritone.

#### PERSONNEL
