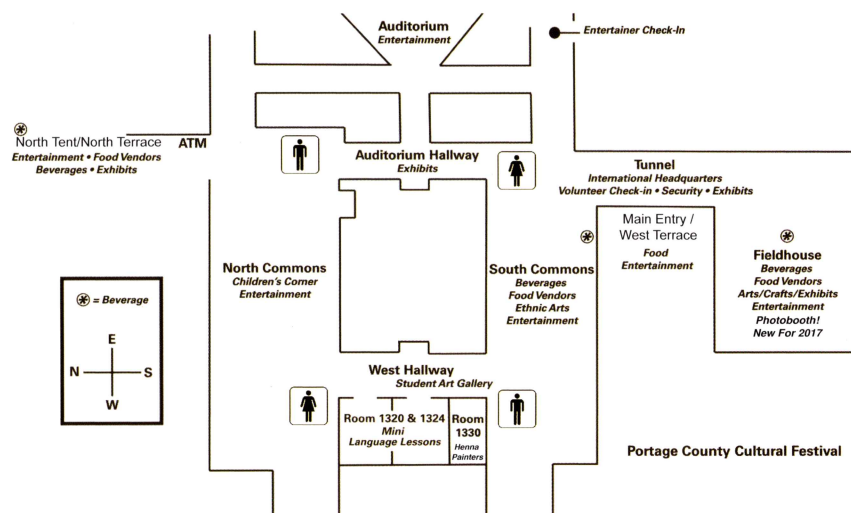

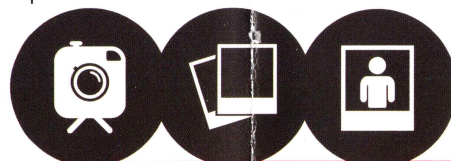
WABA vendors are identified with special signage and balloons. You'll know who's participating by looking for their WABA signage.
