#### 70TH BIRTHDAY FOR BUSINESS

Lila's Super Market in Plover is celebrating a birthday, starting next week. Frank Lila opened the business 70 years ago, in 1902, with dry goods, notions and groceries in one half of a store building and a saloon in the other half. The photo at left shows the old store and tavern, and standing in front, from left, are Gene Woodbury, Felix Lila (Frank's brother), Joe Tomaszewski and Frank Lila. In 1919, David Lila Sr., Frank's son, took over the business. Prohibition was beginning, so he converted the saloon to an ice cream parlor and pool hall which operated until 1930. After that, the business became solely a grocery and dry goods operation. David Lila Sr., now retired and still living in Plover, sold the business in 1957 to his son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Jack Fahrner. They built the present super market in 1959 and doubled its size in 1969. In front of the store, in the photo at right, are David Lila Sr. and Fahrner. The original store, which stood next to the super market, burned a few years ago.



Mamie and Julian Lila, Amherst Junction, celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary Sunday.



Mr. Lila retired in 1961 as a section foreman from the Green Bay and Western Railroad




