FRANK LILA (1862-1939), father of Stephen Lila, opened this business in 1902, with dry goods, notions and groceries in one half of a store building and a saloon in the other half. Standing in front of the store are from left, are Gene Woodbury, Felix Lila (Frank's son), Joe Tomaszewski and Frank Lila. In 1919, David Lila Sr., Frank's son, took over the business. Prohibition was beginning, so he converted the saloon to an ice cream parlor and pool hall which operated until 1930. After that, the business became solely a grocery and dry good operation. Minnie (Lila) Lapinski and Felix Lila worked in the store. Stephen Lila would take eggs from the farm to the grocery store for credit for groceries.







Two From Plover Area Die In Florida

John S. (Jack) Lila, 31, and Mrs. Susan Harris, both of Route 1, Plover, were killed in a traffic accident about 1 p.m. Monday in the West Palm Beach, Fla, area.

Lila was the United Farm Agency representative in this area and had attended the real estate company's recent international awards conference in the Bahamas.

Mrs. Harris was his secretary, and they were visiting her mother in Palm Beach enroute home.

The Florida Highway Patrol said they died in a collision with a truck. Mrs. Harris' daughter, in the back seat, survived the accident.

Lila was born here Oct. 14, 1941, a son of Mr. and Mrs. Stephen Lila, and spent most of his life in the Plover area. He was a graduate of P.J. Jacobs High School.

He had represented United Farm since June 1971 and had won a number of company honors, including the Century Club Award, the Founders Award and the President's Round Table Award, and was the firm's top salesman in the Eldon Updike Southern Wisconsin District for 1972.

Surviving are his mother, Mrs. Sophia Lila, Route 1, Plover; three brothers, Jerome, Dennis and Joseph Lila, Route 1, Plover; a sister, Mrs. Norbert (Antoinette) Kirschling, Route 2, Junction City; and two sons, Rodney and Brad Lila, Route 1, Plover.

He was preceded in death by his father and a sister.

Obituary and funeral information on Mrs. Harris was not available.

Funeral arrangements for Lila are pending at the Dzikoski Funeral Home.

Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Friday at St. Bronislava's Catholic Church, Plover, for John S. (Jack) Lila, who was killed in an automobile accident in Florida Monday.

Friends may call after 2 p.m. Thursday at the Dzikoski Funeral Home, where a general rosary will be recited at 8 p.m.

After graduating from P. J. Jacobs High School, Mr. Lila worked in Milwaukee. He then married the former Bonnie Niemczyk on Dec. 28, 1964, in Rudolph.

The couple then moved to Plover, where Mr. Lila was a self-employed potato buyer before becoming a representative of United Farm Agency.



Wisconsin Pair Killed in State Road 7 Car-Truck Accident . . . four-year-old girl suffered only minor injuries

Dump Truck Rolls Over Car, Couple Killed, Child Survives

A Wisconsin man and woman were killed Monday when their car hit a state Department of Transportation (DOT) dump truck and the truck then rolled over onto their car, sheriff's deputies said.

The dead were identified as Susan Kay Harris, 25, of Stevens Point, Wisc. the driver of the car and John Lida, 32, of Plover, Wisc., a front seat passenger.

Mrs. Harris' four-year-old daughter, Brenda, who was riding in the back seat of the car, was taken to Doctor's Hospital in Lake Worth and treated for minor injuries.

Sheriff's deputies said the DOT truck, driven by Lee Reynolds, 63, of 1416 W. 37th St., Riviera Beach, was traveling north on State Road 7 when a green car in front of him slowed and turned onto Lake Worth Road. Deputies said Reynolds apparently hit his brakes hard to avoid hitting the car in front of him and slid sideways.

The rear of the truck went across State Road 7 and Mrs. Harris' car, traveling South on State Road 7, hit the truck and the truck rolled over on the car, according to deputies.

Deputies said Mrs. Harris and Lida were found dead at the scene.

Reynolds was charged with careless driving by failing to have his vehicle under control.
