First concert – May 25, Memorial Day; rehearsals begin May 26 & 27.

The guest conductor program will continue. Don will contact them and announce their names in each program. One conductor will be chosen in a drawing from names collected during the season and this person will conduct at one of the last concerts.

Don will program on a "theme" basis again this year and one theme will be a "Parade of Pets." The library concert will be June 24 and is titled "Make Waves – Read."

CenterPoint Mall will be the rain site as well as the July 1 concert site. George Seyfarth has requested the band to consider a fall/winter concert schedule in the mall. Further discussions will be held to determine funding, schedule, and available personnel for such an opportunity.
