We provide understanding and acceptance to birth parents, emotional support and assistance to adoptees in their search and education to adoptive parents about the unique needs of their maturing sons and daughters. We are also working towards opening records to allow adoptees and birth relatives to meet by mutual consent. Adoption, Information and Direction, Inc. is a member of American Adoption Congress, a nationwide coalition of individuals who support more openness in adoption.

Jacquelyn has known of her Adoption since an early age. Her (adoptive) parents were honest with her from the start and support her efforts. Jacquelyn is a single mother who just celebrated her 25th birthday and is eager to find the missing pieces to her past whether they be negative or positive.

She is a 1987 graduate of Stevens Point Senior High School and attended Mid-State Technical College. She plans to return to the University of Wisconsin Stevens Point to major in psychology.
