W. F. MEHNE GAS VICTIM

Antigo businessman Succumbs to Auto Fumes in His Garage.

W. F. Mehne, Antigo resident for 50 years and prominent business man, was fatally overcome by carbon monoxide gas in his garage at his home on Fulton street, early this afternoon. Antigo physicians and firemen, using their inhalator worked over him for almost an hour without success.

Miss Margaret Arndt, Penny store employee, on her way home to lunch at one o'clock this afternoon noticed smoke coming from the Mehne garage but she thought nothing of it. On her way back to work, shortly before 2 o'clock, she noticed that the garage was still closed and that there was more smoke pouring out. She looked into the window and saw Mehne in the car. Unable to get help at the Ralph Yentz home next door, where there was no one home, she ran to the A. G. Peters home on Hudson street. Arthur Peters and his son Bryce, called the fire department and with the firemen removed Mehne from the garage. The garage and the house adjoining were filled with gas. The motor of the car was running when the firemen arrived.

The Mehne family was located at Bass Lake. Mr. Mehne had been at home alone. It is believed that he may have suffered a stroke and was unable to get out of the garage. He returned Friday from Rochester where physicians, it is said, warned him that exertion might bring on a fatal attack.

MRS. JOHN HETZEL
Almond Lady Dies Less Than Two Months After Death
of Husband

Less than two months after the death of her husband, Mrs. John Hetzel, one of Portage countys early residents, passed away at her home in the Village of Almond at 6 o'clock Monday morning. For over a year Mrs. Hetzel had been in very poor health due to gallstones. She was operated upon at the Fond du Lac hospital early in the year but this proved to be of little avail and she failed rapidly. For several weeks it was realized she could not long survive.

The deceased was 66 years of age and her maiden name was Mary Mehne. She was a native of Germany but since girlhood she had resided in the Town of Almond, moving to the village only about three months ago. She was widely known among Almond residents, by whom she was greatly esteemed and beloved. Four daughters and three sons survive as follows, Mrs. Otto McCormick, Stockton; Mrs. Fred McCormick, Arnott; Mrs. Homer Rood, Ripon; Mrs. Charles Tess, Spokane, Wash.; Adolph, Daniel and George Hetzel, Town of Almond. She also leaves four brothers and three sisters, Mrs. David Hetzel, Mrs. Micheal Urban, Mrs. David Roth of the Village of Almond, David Micheal and John Mehne of the Town of Almond and Jacob Mehne of this city.

The funeral was held from the German M. E. church at Almond Wednesday afternoon, Rev. Elske officiating. All the children of the deceased except Mrs. Tess were present and among those from this city who attended were M. C. Hetzel, A. A. Hetzel, and Miss Lydia Hetzel.

John Mehne, Sr.

John Mehne, Sr. an early day settler of the town of Almond, died this morning at 3 o'clock at his home. He had been ill for three weeks with heart trouble.

Mr. Mehne was born in Baden, Germany on July 3, 1849. At the age of 15 years he accompanied his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Jacob Mehne Sr. and other members of the family to this country. They left their homeland on April 23, 1864, and after a 47 day ocean voyage arrived in New York. They came directly to Wisconsin and located in the Hetzel vicinity in the town of Almond on July 2, 1864.

Mr. Mehne worked on farms and in lumber camps during the winter in his younger days. On May 12, 1875, his marriage to Miss Barbara Milius took place. They located on a farm in the town of Almond which Mr. Mehne cleared and on which he erected buildings. A number of years later he sold the farm to his nephew, W. F. Hetzel. He then erected a home in the village of Almond where Mr. and Mrs. Mehne still resided. Had Mr. Mehne lived until May 12th, the couple would have celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary.

Surviving are his wife, who is ill and has been confined to bed the greater part of the past winter, a daughter, Mrs. Herman Kehl, of Almond, three sons, John Mehne, Jr. associated with Marshall Wells Co. at Duluth, Minn; Fred Mehne and Walter Mehne, partners in a general merchandise store in Portage; a brother Jacob Mehne, Sr., 733 Water Street, a sister Lena Hetzel of Almond and nine grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

Funeral services will be held Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Emmanuel Church at Almond. Interment will take place in German M.E.Cemetery east of Almond Village.

THE DEATH OF GEORGE MEHNE

Fatal Accident at Almond. Elery D. Frost, of Almond, was in the city yesterday and gave the report of a fatal accident that happened in that town. George Mehne and John Rich were at work digging a well upon Lock Frost's farm, on Thursday morning last. They had reached the great depth of eighty feet, and the rope getting a little too short, they made an improvised hook to place on the end, in which the bucket used in hauling up the clay or sand was placed. Mehne was at work in the bottom of the well, and when near the top the bucket became disengaged from the hook, and fell with lightening-like rapidity to the bottom. Mehne was looking up at the time, and the bucket struck him just above the eye. As quickly as possible he was brought to the surface, in an insensible condition, and medical aid summoned. It was found that the unfortunate fellow had received a fracture of the skull, as well as a concussion of the brain, and he lingered until yesterday morning when death relieved his sufferings. He gained consciousness soon after he was brought to the surface. The deceased was a young man about twenty-five years of age, well liked and respected in the community, and leaves a young wife, to whom he was married last spring, and a number of other relatives to mourn his loss.
