DIED AT GRAND RAPIDS

David Lutz, Sr., who resided and was engaged in
business here many years passed away.....

David Lutz, Sr. a farmer resident of this city, died at his home at Grand Rapids last Sunday morning after a long illness with liver trouble. While he was confined to the house all winter, and gradually grew weaker, he was able to be around until a week before his death. Mr. Lutz came to Stevens Point in 1863 and for a few years worked in the saw mills and on the river but thereafter engaged in the grocery and saloon business which he followed until 1880, when he sold out and moved to Grand Rapids, which city has been his home ever since. He followed the brewing business there for eleven years and from 1891 to 1902 was engaged in farming but since the latter year he had resided in this city. He was born near Baden, Germany, Dec. 19, 1836 and was therefore in the 72nd year of his age. He is survived by his wife, two sons, David and Jacob and one daughter, Mrs. Edward Krouse all of Grand Rapids. David Lutz was well liked by all who knew him, being a great hearted, whole souled man ever ready to assist a friend and help the needy. His taking away is deeply regretted.

The funeral was held at Grand Rapids at 1 o'clock this afternoon the services being in charge of the Stumpf Lodge No. 225, I.O.O.F. of this city, he being a charter member of that lodge and had ever since retained his membership. Mr. and Mrs. George Oertel and sons Norman and Robert, Mr. and Mrs. William Manthey, Mr. and Mrs. Charles Lutz, Mr. and Mrs. Robert Lutz and daughter Loraine, were at Wisconsin Rapids this afternoon, driving there to attend the funeral of their aunt, Mrs. David Lutz, Sr., who died last Saturday at the home of a daughter, Mrs. C. E. Krause. The deceased 90th birthday anniversary is today. When the Lutz Brothers operated a brewery on South Water Street, where the Stevens Point Beverage Company is now located, David Lutz and his family were residents of this city. They later moved to the Rapids, where the husband and father died 19 years ago.

Mrs. Lutz was a native of Baden, Germany, born there Oct. 25, 1837. She was the last surviving member of the original family of Lutz's who in the early days of Stevens Point and Portage County were quite numerous and took a leading part in its civic and business development. Surviving Mrs. Barbara Lutz are two sons, David and Jacob and the daughter Mrs. Krause all located at Wisconsin Rapids. She also leaves six grandchildren, seven great-grandchildren, and one great-great-grandchild.

JACOB LUTZ DEAD

Jacob Lutz of Grand Rapids, died at St. Mary's Hospital, Oshkosh, last evening where he was taken several weeks ago for treatment. He had been in poor health for the past two or three years, being troubled from a partial loss of eyesight as well as general debility and as a last resort he went to Oshkosh with the hope of finding relief.

Mr. Lutz was a native of Baden, Germany where he was born Jan. 16, 1840 and came to America when 19 years of age, coming direct to Wisconsin and as a young man learned the brewing business in this city, afterwards being associated with his brother Andrew, as proprietor of the Stevens Point Brewery. In 1880 he moved to Grand Rapids, engaging in the same business there with his brother David, but for the past few years had followed no occupation.

He is survived by three brothers, Micheal and David of Grand Rapids, and John Lutz, Sr. of this city. The deceased gentleman had many friends, all of whom will regret to learn of his death. He was a member of Stumpf Lodge, I.O.O.F. of this city. The funeral will take place Friday afternoon at Grand Rapids and a number of Odd Fellows and other friends from here will no doubt attend.

Jacob Lutz was born at Eckartsweier, Baden, Germany, January 16, 1840, and died at Oshkosh, May 28, 1901 in the 61st year of his age. He came to this country in 1860 and settled at Almond in Portage County, where he worked with his brother Andrew on a farm for three or four years. He then went to Stevens Point and went to work in a brewery which he and his brother Andrew bought in 1865. This they continued to operate until 1880, when he and his brother David came to Grand Rapids and bought the brewery of Nicholas Schmitt, and since that time they have made this city their home. In the family were five boys and two girls, all of whom came to America including the parents. Three brothers - Mike, John and David are the surviving members of the family. Michael and David live in this city and John lives in Stevens Point.
