DIED AT McDILL

Michael Walter died at the home of his brother-in-law, John Lutz, at McDill at half-past five o'clock on Sunday evening last, after only a four day's illness. Death was caused by pneumonia. The deceased was born in Baden, Germany, May 16th, 1821, and was therefore in the 73rd year of his age. His wife died in their native land eleven years ago, and the father and children came to America about one year thereafter. Coming direct to Stevens Point, they stayed here a short time, after which they went to live on a farm near Amherst Junction, which is now occupied by a son, Michael, Jr. About six months ago the old gentleman went to live with Mr. Lutz, and continued to make his home there until he died. The funeral took place from the home at 2 o'clock Tuesday afternoon, Rev. E. P. Rankin officiating, with interment in the Episcopal (Forest) cemetery. The pallbearers were Fred. Stieler, George Oertel, George Urban, Michael Lutz, Carl Lutz, and John Hoerter. The deceased leaves two sons, John and Michael.

MICHAEL WALTERS

Michael Walters, aged 81, died last evening at the home of his son, J. C. Walters, Eighth avenue.

The deceased was born in Baden, Germany, on November 13, 1855, and he came to America in 1883, settling at Almond, Wisconsin. He married Mary Rege at Wisconsin Rapids in 1890. They lived in Amherst, Wausau, and Aniwa after their marriage and moved to a farm in the town of Ackley in 1905. Mrs. Walters died there in 1924. Soon after her death Mr. Walters came to Antigo where he had lived with his son for the past six years.

Four sons survive. They are Jake C. and George of Antigo, William of Mattoon, and Fred of Chicago.

Funeral services will be held at the home of J. C. Walters, 106 Eighth avenue, at 2:30 pm on Friday. Burial will be in the Elmwood cemetery.

FUNERAL RITES FRIDAY FOR JAKE C. WALTERS

Jake C. Walter, 83, of 106 Eighth Ave., died Tuesday evening at the Langlade County Memorial Hospital. He was born July 5, 1891 in Amherst to the late Mr. and Mrs. Michael Walters. As a child he moved with his parents to Wausau, ~~Aniwa~~ and the town of Peck where he grew up. In 1925 he moved to Antigo where he had resided since. ^{24 Sept 1974}

On June 19, 1929 he married the former Ruth Adams in Wausau. She survives. Mr. Walters was a cabinet maker and vice-president of the former Building Supply company of Antigo, where he worked for 47 years prior to retiring in 1964.

Surviving besides his wife are a son, James of Appleton, a brother William of Plover and three grandchildren. He was preceded in death by two brothers, Fred and George.

Mr. Walters was a member of Peace Lutheran Church, Antigo, where funeral rites will be held Friday at 2 pm. The Rev. Joseph Schultz and the Rev. JOHN WALTER

John Walter of the town of Grant, a resident of that vicinity for the past 50 years, died at his home Tuesday afternoon at 2:25 o'clock after a lingering illness.
