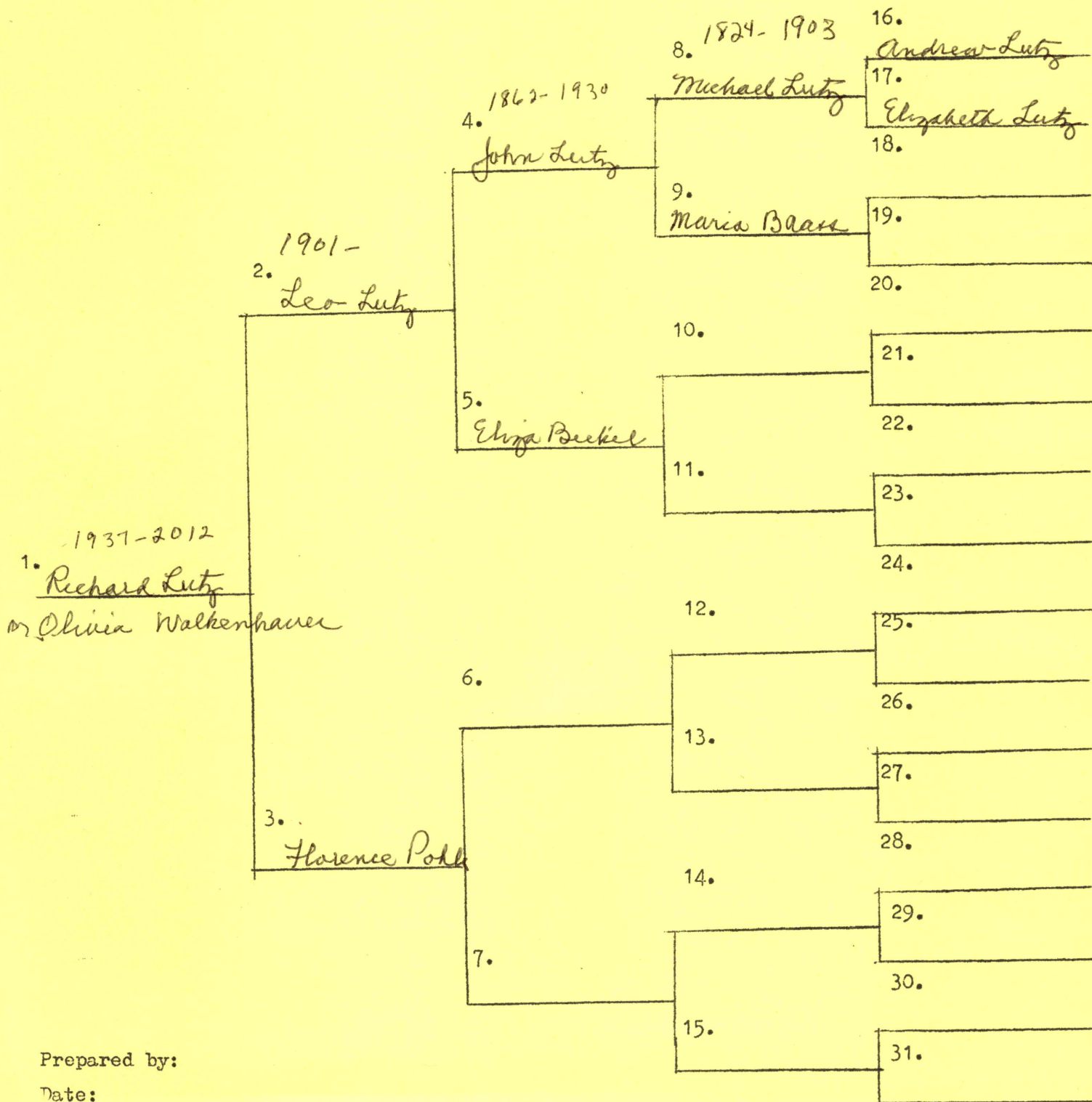

### DEATH OF MIKE LUTZ, SR.

The remains of Micheal Lutz, Sr. arrived here from Grand Rapids last Monday, were laid to rest in the Episcopal Cemetary, services being conducted by Rev. M. Entzminger, pastor of German M.E. Church. Mr. Lutz was a native of Baden, Germany, where he was born 79 years ago last February and lived in the Fatherland until about 30 years ago, when he emigrated to the United States and for upwards of 15 years owned and occupied a farm near Amherst Junction. A few years ago he transferred his property to his sons, Micheal and John and bought a residence at Grand Rapids.

A couple of weeks ago he went to visit another son, Jacob, on a farm about four miles north of the Rapids. The infirmities of old age had left his constitution in a weakened condition, but he was able to be up and around the house until a day or two before his death, which accured at 11 o'clock last Saturday night. Mr. Lutz was the second child in a family of five children, all of whom have passed away except two brothers, John Lutz of this city, and David Lutz of Grand Rapids. The deceased gentleman leaves three sons and two daughters, Mike, John, and Mrs. Charles Lutz of Amherst Junction; Mrs. George Lutz of Almond, and Jacob Lutz of Grand Rapids. He had been married three times, his first wife dying in the old country, the second one passing away on their farm near Amherst Junction; and the third wife is still living at the Rapids. Many old friends from different parts of Portage and Wood County were here to pay their last respects to his memory.

Micheal Lutz

Micheal Lutz, former Stevens Point resident and retired farmer of the Town of Amherst, died this morning in a hospital at Fort Benton, Montana. Word of his death was received at the home of his son, George Lutz, 319 Mathilda Street. It is planned to bring the remains here although it was not known today when the funeral party will arrive.

Mr. Lutz had been in the West a year making his home with his daughter, Mrs. Frank Hall, who was formerly Miss Emma Lutz at Shonkin, Montana. He had been a patient at the Fort Benton hospital for the past two weeks, receiving treatment for a tumor of the kidney.

The deceased was 80 years of age and was a native of Baden, Germany. He came to the United States 56 years ago locating at once in Stevens Point, where he was employed for a number of years at the Lutz Brewery. His marriage to Miss Elizabeth Urban took place in Stevens Point. Mr. Lutz purchased a farm in the town of Amherst, which he operated for many years or until 10 years ago when he sold it and retired, removed to Amherst Junction.

In addition to the daughter in the West and the son in this city he is survived by three other sons, William Lutz, of Antigo, Albert Lutz of Amherst Junction and Herman Lutz of Nekoosa, by two brothers, Jacob Lutz of Wisconsin Rapids and David Lutz of Minneapolis and by two sisters, Mrs. Mary Lutz of Almond and Mrs. Elizabeth Lutz of Amherst. Another brother John died at Amherst last October. Mrs. Micheal Lutz died on June 18, 1929 and is buried in Greenwood Cemetery, Amherst.

Mr. Lutz was a member of the Stumpf Lodge of Odd Fellows for many years. This body was afterward consolidated with Shaurette Lodge and the organization is now known as Stevens Point Lodge No. 92. He was also a member of Peace Evangelical Church here.

GEORGE LUTZ

George Lutz, 79, 319 Matilda street, a resident of Portage County most of his life, died Saturday afternoon at 4:15 o'clock at St. Michael's hospital, where he had been a patient since last Thursday afternoon. He had been ill since Thanksgiving day.

He was born in Germany on Dec. 7, 1872, a son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Michael Lutz. He came to the United States at the age of two, with his parents, to live on a farm near Amherst Junction. He attended the old Felsch school there.

Mr. Lutz resided at home until his marriage at Amherst Junction on Aug. 3, 1895 to the former Christina Hoerter, also of that village. The couple moved to Stevens Point, where he was employed by the Whiting-Plover Paper company. He later held employment with various firms and for about 25 years was a checker at the freight house of the Soo Line railroad. He retired due to ill health in 1939.

Mr. Lutz was a member of the Modern Woodmen of America and the Brotherhood of Railway and Steamship Clerks, Freight Handlers, Express and Station Employees. He was also a member of Peace Evangelical and Reformed church.

He was a supervisor for the Sixth ward from 10 years, from 1940 until 1950, when he resigned. He is survived by the widow, four sons, William, Joliet, Ill., Elmer, at home, Alfred, 316 Matilda street, and Norman, 1120 Church street; two daughters, Mrs. Bernard Berscheid, Joliet, Ill., and Mrs. Kenneth Reading of South Milwaukee; 13 grand children and 11 great grand children; two brothers, Albert Lutz, Amherst Junction and Herman Lutz, Nekoosa, and one sister, Mrs. Frank Hall of Shonkin, Mont.

A graddaughter, Joyce Lutz, who died last May, one brother and a sister preceeded him in death.

### Elmer O. Lutz

Elmer O. Lutz, 319 Mathilda Street was pronounced dead on arrival at St. Michaels Hospital after suffering a heart attack at his home shortly after noon Sunday. He was 63 years old.

Mr. Lutz was born in the Town of Amherst on July 16, 1897, was a son of the late Mr. & Mrs. George Lutz. When he was a few months old, the family moved to Stevens Point and he attended the 6th Ward (McKinley) School here.

During World War I, he served as an army private from Oct. 14 to Dec. 18, 1918.

Alfred M. Lutz, 78, 1332 Mathilda Street, died early this morning at St. Micheals Hospital.

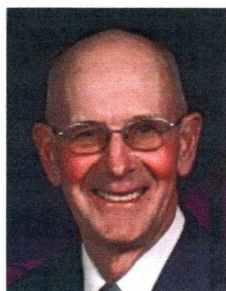
She attended Stevens Point normal school and after graduation taught at Riverview School in Waupaca County until her marriage.
