The Grin 'N Tonics were organized in August 1968 and combine over 50 years of barbershopping experience in 12 previous quartets. Their first contest efforts, in Racine, November 1968, resulted in a fifth place finish in the Land 'O Lakes District. At the same time they captured the LOL Novice Quartet Championship. The following year they won the LOL District Championship at Oshkosh. In both 1969 and 1970 they were finalists in the LOL International Preliminary Quartet Contest. The "Tonics" have appeared on barbershop shows in five states and are in great demand in the Fox Valley area.
