SINGING VALENTINES
QUARTET BRIEFING SHEET

- UNIFORM: black tux with formal shirt, red bow-tie & red cummerbund, black shoes, red silk-rose boutonniere
- PRICING: \$25 per delivery with two-hour time span; \$35 for exact time delivery
- INCLUDED: each singing valentine includes a red long-stemmed rose with fern and water tube, a personal valentine card to be presented by the quartet; the song *Heart of My Heart* will be performed; a second optional song such as *Let Me Call You Sweetheart* may be sung depending on the quartet's desire; a Polaroid picture of the Quartet with the Valentine recipient will be taken.
- DELIVERY: a quartet spokesman should announce the purpose of the visit to all curious onlookers, and then "setup" the performance by presenting the rose, card, and song(s).

Focus attention on the recipient of the valentine. Arrange for someone in the crowd to take the picture if you do not have a 5th man along. Depart quickly after presenting the picture. Each delivery should take no longer than 5 minutes.

- IMPORTANT: **Smile! Have a good time. It's a fun day for you, a surprise for the receiver of the valentine, and your attitude should be joyful.**

OTHER DETAILS:

Roses will be picked up at Harmony House, stored in the beer cooler. Quartets must assemble a rose, fern, and water tube in a plastic sleeve prior to presentation. Please take only the number of roses you need for your valentine deliveries.

If you run short of roses for any reason and the supply at Harmony House is exhausted, you may charge more at Bev's Floral on North Division Street, next to JR Liquor Store. Or simply purchase more as needed wherever convenient and present the receipt for reimbursement.

Quartet members may purchase a rose and delivery to their Sweetheart for a cost of \$5.

Valentine drivers may be reimbursed for the cost of their gas. Present a bill to the Treasurer if you so desire.
