Come, O Long Expected Jesus, for SATB choir, string orchestra, and continuo, was commissioned by Patrick Burkhart for performance at the 2009 Advent Preludes Concert. The piece is based on the hymn of the same name, originating in the 18th Century, with text by Charles Wesley and tune by Christian F. Witt. This work is arranged in the manner of a Baroque cantata chorus, with extensive opening and closing orchestral ritornelli and transitions linking choral elaborations on the three segments of the hymn. For this setting, the composer used the 3 lines of the first verse as the basis for extended choral episodes, interspersed with more active string writing, and supported by the harmonic foundation of the solid basso continuo throughout. The text is:

“Come, O Long Expected Jesus, born to set your people free.
From our fears and sins release us, free us from captivity.”

Come, O Long Expected Jesus is a triumphant, jubilant piece celebrating the joy of the Advent season and the anticipation of Christmas. It is both challenging and accessible on different levels for choir and orchestra, and intended to be an uplifting and pleasing offering for all listeners this holiday season.



