After considerable discussion regarding conditions on Beach it was felt it would be to the interest of Taxepayers to form an Association and it was so moved by Mr. Durance; seconded by Mr. Trace that an Association be formed and known as the New Wasaga Beach Ratepayers Association with Messrs Devitt and Forsey Acting respectively as provisional officers President and Secretary. CARRIED.

Mr. Devitt - reported - Re Hydro

That service would be given to Residences by August if desired; if not Mr. Flannery of the Hydro gave Mr. Devitt and undertaking that we would have service in the early spring.

There was considerable discussion regarding speeding on Beach, Camping without proper accommodation., the question of Garbage, Indecent exposure, Road improvements and Keeping up community spirit by some annual entertainment.

Mr. Trace and Mr. Devitt were appointed a committee to notify the Provincial Officer regarding any condition that migh arise requiring action.

Moved by Mr. Durance, seconded by Mr. Chandler that the meeting be adjourned 8.25 o'clock Standard time.

Mr. Devitt was asked to take the chair.
Mr. Forsey was asked to act as secretary.

Mr. Devitt reported re Hydro progress.
This report was accepted.

Mr. Devitt reported on visit to Township Council by committee: Messrs, Forsey, Trace, and Devitt regarding Garbage Collection. He stated that the council were compelled by provincial board of Health to make these collections owing to complaints from old Beach. After considerable discussion on this report and a statement that a charge of (\$2.00) per cottage was the rate at the old Beach; the council was charging (\$3.25) per cottage at our Beach.

Moved by Mr. J. Stewart, seconded by Mrs Galbraith that the name of New Wasaga Beach be changed to Allenwood Beach. CARRIED.

Election of Officers

Moved by Mr. Durance seconded by Mr. Kenyon that Mr. Devitt be elected PRESIDENT. CARRIED.

Moved by Mr. Trace seconded by Mr. Kielly that Mr. Durance be elected VICE PRESIDENT. CARRIED

Moved by Mrs Forsey seconded by Mr. Cameron that Mr. Trace be elected TREASURER CARRIED.

Moved by Mr. Durance seconded by Mr. Kenyon that Mr. Forsey be elected SECRETARY. CARRIED.

Moved by Mr. Kenyon seconded by Mr. Kielly that a committee consisting of: Messrs, Devitt, Trace, and Forsey go into the question of Garbage Collection again advising council of the association objections to the excessive charges. CARRIED.

Moved by Mrs Forsey seconded by Mr. Durance that a few signs be erected prohibiting camping. CARRIED.


Moved by Miss Freeborn seconded by Mr. Stewart that Mr. Trace be asked to interview the sitting member Mr. Simpson re-improvements in Mail service during the months of July and August. CARRIED.

Moved by Mr. Stewart seconded by Mr. Kielly that the membership fee for the Association be (.50¢) per year. CARRIED.

Moved by Mr. Devitt seconded by Mr. Kenyon that the following committee: Mrs. Chandler, Mrs Durance, Mrs Galbraith, Mrs Forsey, Miss Freeborn be appointed to arrange for a community entertainment for the season of 1933. CARRIED.

Moved by Mr. Trace seconded by Mr. Kenyon that we adjourn till called by chair. CARRIED.

The meeting opened as usual with the reading of the minutes of the last meeting.

Mr. Trace reported waiting on Mr. Simpson M.P. regarding improvement in Mail Service which he was pleased to report had been attended to satisfactorily.

Mr. Devitt reported on visit of committee to Board of Health, Parliament Buildings re Garbage collection; and reported that owing to conditions at our beach they would waive previous order and allow reductions in collections consistent with the order of the Township council.

Mr. Trace waiting on council re Garbage collection re-
ported and stated in future their would only be two collections per week. Tuesday and Friday and cost of same would be charged in regular taxes spread over all property owners.

Business arising out of Minutes:

Re Signs & Enforcement.

After considerable discussion and report of visit to (Crown Lands Dept, Parliament Buildings); where they stated that we as property owners approached the Township Council and had someone sworn-in as special constable they would *invest them* with control of the beach.

Moved by Mr. Durance, seconded by Mr. Cardy that a committee composed of Mr. Devitt, Mr. Trace and Mr. Durance wait on council.
CARRIED.

Re name of Beach:

Moved by Mr. Stewart, seconded by Mrs. Galbraith to resind previous motion re-naming of beach Allenwood Beach and open the subject for further discussion. CARRIED.

After considerable discussion and suggestions it was moved by Mr. Cardy seconded by Mr. Stewart that three names be chosen and submitted to all property owners for their coments and opinions. CARRIED.

The names chosen were "Allenwood Beach" named after two fromer residents Mr. Allen & Mr. Wood. "Kabeyum Beach" an indian name meaning West Winds. "Kairawan Beach" an indian name meaning Resting Place.

New Business:

Mr. Stewart brought up the question of cultivating a more Social ~~Committy~~ spirit and live so much to ourselves particularly in the interest of the young folk and keep them interested in our own beach. A motion was moved by Mr. Durance seconded by Miss Munroe that a committee consisting of Mr. Stewart, Mr. Forsey, Miss Munroe, Miss Nicholls, with power to add some of the young folk to organize some activity to foster a deeper community interest. CARRIED.

The question was raised regarding the restriction^{ing} of pedlars on the beach with supplies, which had seriously affected the source of supplies, and all felt this measure was a great hardship and most unfair to property owners and it was moved by Mr. Durance seconded by Mrs. Forsey that the committee composed of ~~Messrs~~ Devitt, Trace and Durance waiting on council bring this serious matter to the attention of council, asking to have the restriction resinded. CARRIED.

Moved by Mr. Trace seconded by Miss Munroe that we adjourn till called by chair.

It was moved by Mr. Durance seconded by Mr. Cardy that we adopt the name of "Allenwood Beach"., and that the treasurer Mr. Trace be authorized to procure the necessary signs and place same at strategic points. CARRIED.

Considerable discussion was given to a petition presented by Mr. Durance, that we as an a association pledge ourselves to restrict any further business activities on the Beach, (no action was taken).

A motion was made by Mr. Armstrong seconded by Mr. Durance, that a Department consisting of Messrs: Devitt, Yardley, Cardy, Durance and Armstrong wait on Mr. Cotton Prop. of Noah's Ark asking him to co-operate with the other property owners in their wish, that he move his building back in line with the other buildings. CARRIED.
