Birch Haven is eighty-three miles from Toronto and is situated on the north shore of the Nottawasaga River at the entrance to Nancy Island. Here you can enjoy the shade of the silver birches and yet be within one minute of the Bay, which has the finest sand beach in Canada.

Birch Haven Cabins surround the Lodge and are artistically situated in a beautiful birch grove beside the water. They are electrically lighted and are furnished with additional sockets for electric razor, iron, etc. The fully-screened windows are placed so as to ensure cross ventilation, and are equipped with awnings. The beds and mattresses are modern and offer the utmost in comfort.

The Lodge comprises the Lounge, Dining Room, Kitchen and Office. The Lounge, which commands an unobstructed view of the river, is very comfortably furnished, and has a large stone fireplace, which lends a particularly cheerful atmosphere during inclement weather.

The Dining Room also overlooks the river, and is airy and inviting. It is tastefully furnished and is a perfect setting in which to enjoy our "Meals that Merit Mention".

Meals

If you are particular about your meals, we are confident that you will enjoy the meals at Birch Haven. The food is the best procurable, including pasteurized milk and cream, eggs, fresh young poultry, fish, vegetables, etc. We feature chicken and turkey dinners, also fresh-caught Georgian Bay trout or whitefish. Sports

If you enjoy boating or fishing you can secure the free use of a boat. You may swim in the river

or bathe in the bay. Sports of all kinds are near at hand; dancing, roller-skating, horse-back riding, cycling, golf, tennis, alley bowling, etc.

Relaxation

Whether you long to relax on a deck chair, under the trees beside the water, or in the privacy of your well-ventilated cabin, Birch Haven offers you ample opportunity to do so. On cool evenings or rainy days, the cosy lounge room will perhaps be your choice.

Location

Two minutes' walk takes you to the main street of the Town of Wasaga Beach, where Shops, Beauty Parlors, Post Office, etc., are located. Birch Haven is two doors from the Community Church and within walking distance of the Roman Catholic Church.

Transportation

Bus service (Gray Coach Line) to Wasaga Beach. Birch Haven is only two minutes' walk from bus terminal. Train service to Stayner. Taxi to Wasaga. If motoring take Highway No. 11 to Barrie, then Highway No. 27 to Elmvale. Good road from Elmvale to Wasaga Beach takes you direct to the main street of the town. Turn left immediately after crossing the bridge to Birch Haven, 35 Mosely Street.






