

Hugh Torrance House and Store, Inc.

Compiled April-October 1990 by Brad Rauschenberg

The following material culture categories contain a chronological listing of the purchasing and selling evidence as found in the Torrance-Banks Family Papers which have been placed on microfilm by the Special Collections section of the J. Murrey Atkins Library of the University of North Carolina at Charlotte. Though the papers represent a period of 1769-post 1860, the material selected for this study is from the 1805-1825 period of the merchandise acquired in Philadelphia and Charleston. The categories selected for the divisions are for the ease of accessing and are not found so arranged or termed in the original records. This study is for the purpose of understanding the material culture items handled by the Hugh Torrance store.

The arrangement of the original records for microfilming was based primarily on the selection via folders by Mr. Richard Torrance Banks, the owner of the original documents. The collection has now been donated to the University of North Carolina at Charlotte and are housed in the Dalton Rare Book & Manuscript Room, 10th Floor, Dalton Library Tower.

The records are arranged into two series: Subject files (reels 1-2) and Accounting Records (reel 3). The citations include a reference to the record used and follow the numerical system as outlined by the calendar (1-6 to 1-18) prepared by the University

Reel #1, Folder 5 will be cited as R-1#5. Page numbering is given as found in the original documents; where page numbering was not found, numbering is assigned with the numbering given in brackets. Where the document is dated and the origin of the goods are given, this will be included also cited. The selected material will be cited in its entirety with brackets added for clarification notations.

Initials will be used for the principal: H.T. (Hugh Torrance) and J.T.(James Galbraith Torrance).

The evidence will be divided into two parts: merchandise purchased in Charleston and Philadelphia (1.) and merchandise sold by the store (2.). The reason for this is to maintain clear access to the two categories if this was ever needed. The categories were assigned on the basis of the findings in part one (1.); identical categories were presented in part two (2.). In part two there are categories which do not have an entry, this is as there was no evidence for this item being sold, though purchased by the store.
