Dear Chairwoman Kaptur and Ranking Member Simpson,

We, the undersigned Members of Congress who represent constituents downstream of the Uranium Mill Tailing Remedial Action (UMTRA) project, urge you to match last year's funding of \$67,000,000 for Fiscal Year 2024. Notably, we believe sustaining this amount would save taxpayer dollars by further maximizing productivity and allowing the project to finally be completed. According to the Department of Energy (DOE), stable funding would finish the relocation and disposal of tailings by 2027, and complete site activities in 2029.

DOE has been tasked with the cleanup of this site, which includes the largest uranium mill tailings pile relocation in the United States. Currently, DOE is moving approximately one million tons of uranium mill tailings annually to the Crescent Junction disposal site.

Historic funding increases made the site significantly more efficient, which allowed DOE to move more tailings at less cost per ton. In fact, the cost per ton went from \$81 to \$47, with tons per month seeing an increase from 39,000 to 80,000. Once it is complete, the removal of these tailings could result in numerous economic development opportunities for the local community and provide a peace of mind for our downstream constituencies.

We appreciate your consideration of this request and the impact it will have on our constituents.
