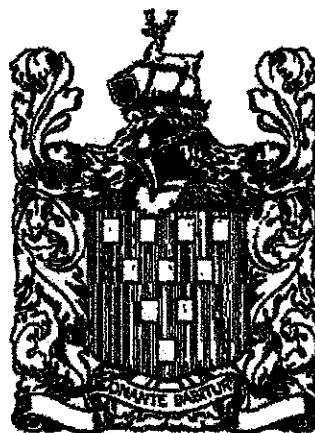


Conant

WILLIAM ALBERT CONANT, of Brookline, Massachusetts; *b.* 19th December, 1865; unmarried; was educated at Boston Public Schools and Massachusetts Institute of Technology; is engaged in the manufacture of rubber goods, under the title of W. H. CONANT Gosamer Rubber Company.



Lineage

JOHN CONANT, of Devonshire, England; *b.* there circa 1520; was the father of

RICHARD CONANT, who *m.* in England, 4th February, 1578, Agnes CLARKE, dau. of John CLARKE; he was church warden and one of the leading citizens of East Burleigh.

ISSUE

- i. Rev. John, D.D., was Rector of Lyminster, afterward Rector of Thomas à Becket, Salisbury, County Wilts; he preached a sermon by invitation 26th July, 1623, before the Commons, for which he received a vote of thanks; it was published by order of the Commons; it was on the "Woe and Weale of God's People;" he was one of the Assembly of Divines that put forth the Westminster catechism.
- ii. ROGER of Salem, *bapt.* 9th April, 1592, of whom later.

HON. ROGER CONANT, of Salem, Massachusetts; *bapt.* 9th April, 1592, in East Burleigh, Devonshire, England; *d.* 19th November, 1679, in Salem, Massachusetts; resided for a time in London and came from there on the ship *Ann*, arriving at Plymouth on July, 1623, with wife Sarah and son Caleb; he moved to Hull, thence to Gloucester in 1625 and from there with his small Gloucester Company to Salem, in 1626; he built the first house in Salem; was planter; Member of the General Court, 1634; Foreman of the Jury of General Trials; Justice of the Quarterly Court in Salem; prominent in all public affairs; one of the original members of the first church in Salem, 1637; was Governor of the Colony at Cape Ann, 1625-1626; and Salem, 1627-1629; *m.* in England, 11th November, 1618, Sarah HORTON.

ISSUE

- i. Sarah, *bapt.* in London, England, 19th September, 1619; buried there 30th October, 1620.
- ii. Caleb, *bapt.* same place, 27th May, 1622.
- iii. LOZ, *b.* circa 1624, of whom later.
