Every effort will be made to process your claim promptly. Correspondence may delay your claim, so please allow us time to complete our adjudication. When we authorize your first check we will, of course, include any back annuity due so there will be no loss to you for the time we need to do our work.

As soon as we complete your claim, we will let you know the amount of your annuity, when to expect your first annuity check, and other information of importance to you as a retired employee of the U.S. Government.

Please notify us promptly of any change in your address, referring to your retirement claim number (CSA-) shown on the same line as your name on the other side of this card. We suggest you also notify your postmaster if you change your address so he can forward your mail.
