Some Clark (Ivy) Genealogy compiled by Louis T. Clark

In 1790 David, John + James Clark three brothers came to what is now Howard County (then (a?) of Anne Arundel) Maryland. David's passport described him as a sober, industrious and upright young man.

They came from northern and were Protestant. James soon departed for parts still unknown. John stayed and became ancestor of James, grandfather of Arthur Percy Forsythe and of numerous clarks including families James Booker, Garnett (deceased) John Lawrence, James Clark (lawyer at Ellicott City) and Edward Talbott Clark, his brother. The father of the last two John L. Clark and the father of the first three was John's brother James, who was president of the Depositors and Mechanic Bank Baltimore Md. ~~here~~, He was a confederate and made a million. David also stayed

grandfather. From this marriage came
Aunt, who became Mrs Lot Lenthicum a
relative of your uncle George Washington

Bradley [Lenthicum - of Martin, Tex] will
recall her at reunion of Louis T. Clark's

photograph. The Governor's Mothers
was Margaret Watkins. Her sister
Albina Charlotte William Clark's
wife was youngest child, born
DEC 5 1822 when Col Gassaway Watkins
was 72). "Wallis Warfield is descendant
of * Richard Warfield 1st through
her great grandfather Daniel
whose home near Cooksville, still stands.
David Clark married Rachel Warfield
in late 1790's Their children (not
listed in every instance according to dates)

and became ancestor of Thaddeus S. Clark Jr. Father of "Lillian Clark Lucy", Rosa Clark Thrash and Edwin Clark. David was born in 1771 in Ireland. His tombstone gives his death as Sept 9, 1835, aged 64 yr. He married Rachel Warfield, daughter of Samuel and Mary Chavey Warfield, who were married in 1791. Rachel was a descendant of Richard Warfield, 1st the immigrant, who was in this country prior to his settlement near Annapolis in 1662. He was progenitor of Gen. Edwin Warfield and of other Warfields. The Governor's own aunt Albina Charlotte Watkins daughter of Col. Gassaway Watkins and Eleanor Bowie Clagett [cousin of 1st Episcopal Bishop in America] married William Clark brother of Thaddeus S. Clark Sr.

So the Governor was related by blood distantly, and as a family connection. It is interesting to know that Uncle Williams' Clark's daughter (1109 calvert St. Baltimore now approaching 80, Albina Charlotte Clark, is the granddaughter of a revolutionary soldier viz. Col. Gassaway Watkins born 1750 first married Sarah Jones, after revolution, no issue.
