Now, therefore, whereas there has been a petition filed in the office of the Clerk of the County Court of Bollinger County in the State of Missouri praying this Court to make an order changing the name of the County Seat of said County from that of Dallas to that of Marble Hill and it being proved to this Court that two-thirds of the citizens of Dallas as aforesaid have signed said petition and that due notice of the filing of said petition as above has been given by publication in the Bollinger County Standard a newspaper printed in said County for three weeks prior thereto as appears by the affidavit of Murdock and Adams, by Lindsay Murdock, filed with this Court,

Therefore it is ordered that the name of the County Seat of said County be and the same hereby is changed from that of Dallas to that of Marble Hill, to take effect from and after the date of this order.

Ordered by the Court that John J. Duffy be and he hereby is appointed Commissioner of the seat of Justice at the town of Marble Hill in the said County of Bollinger and State of Missouri to have and to hold said office for two years.
