some little thing to the church? Ours
is a small little parish of not more

The "Holy Ghost" + "St Cecilia" windows
are in vestibule.

Over the main door + also over
the vestibule door are five little sections
of cathedral ^{or rather} glass - shouldn't there also
be of same quality of glass + same colour
as yours to give proper effect? You
might ask Dr Michael for dimensions
they are about 12 in middle $\frac{1}{2}$ 8. Each one is of
different size + shape than the other also
ask Dr Michael to give you the size of the
large window in choir + give me an
approximate figure of cost - without labour
- with - + with a figure. I have no
prospect yet but it would be well to be
able to quote a price
