Dear Mrs. Pitassi:

I am writing to confirm the arrangement made with Louise and Father Hinnebusch relative to the making of the clerestory windows for the Church of the Assumption, Bellevue.

The most efficient method of producing these windows was to transfer the job to our studio and in this both Louise and Father Hinnebusch agreed.

Father Hinnebusch has signed a contract with us in the amount of \$ 11,000.00 to be paid in four equal payments of 25%. Out of this amount 20% of each payment will be forwarded to you people as compensation for the designing and supervision Louise will furnish. The materials are to be furnished by us with the exception of a few special colors that are to be taken from your inventory.

I believe this arrangement will be of mutual benefit to both studios and perhaps form the basis for further cooperation.

Sorry that I never seem to find time to visit you. My time seems taken up with immediate problems which seems to be the tempo of the times.
