
I give below copy of telegram sent you last night.

"We are mailing you pattern for 13 windows and are sending by express the wood sash stop Rose window is of solid concrete and will have to be put in two pieces stop Write us fully what information you want regarding this Understand you will supply all ventilators."

I am very much interested in your supplying these ventilators complete so we will just have to put the glass in place. As explained in the telegram, we are sending by express the sash, and by mail the measurements of the thirteen windows. Any further information you want, please advise us.

In connection with the Rose Window, if you will tell us just what you want, we will send you blueprint or tracing. This is going to be in two parts, as I understand it, so we can put the glass in, and then set the concrete stone one-half down on the other.
