On request of Father Michael, O.S.B. I am submitting to you the following quotations on the Stained Glass for the Clemson College Chapel Windows.

No 1-- 13 Aisle Windows. Grisaille Type with superimposed figure in each lancet.	Price of each lancet-----	\$ 136,00
No 2-- 1 Rose Window in the center		\$ 180,00
No 3-- 1 Circular Window above Altar		\$ 100,00
No 4-- Transom over front door		\$ 65,00
No 5-- Sacristy Windows		\$ 36,00

The first four items on this list are to be carried out in the best imported English Antique Glass and Norman Slabs with appropriate design as discussed by me with Father Michael. As under the rules of the N.R.A. I am not allowed to submit drawings or designs without adequate compensation and as time does not allow me to take up this matter with you, Father Michael is mailing to you under cover a drawing for one of the Aisle Windows submitted by me to him and for which he assumes responsibility of payment if the contract is not awarded to me.

I wish to assure you that the prices given are most reasonable for the type of work intended and they have been gone over item by item by Father Michael himself and so given to you

If the contract is awarded to me the matter of payment should be taken up in the following manner: 10 % on awarding the contract, 15 % when the drawings are made, 25 % when the glass is cut and 50 % when the finished work is received by you

Prices as given are F.O.B. Pittsburgh and ventilators will be furnished by you according to my measurements and if you so desire I shall order them for you and bill them to you on
