You are hereby authorized to proceed with the making of the balance of the stained glass windows for St. Benedict's Church, to be of the same class of workmanship and materials as in Aisle Window already in place, which is part of this agreement; the price of Aisle Windows to be \$700.00 each and for the Sanctuary Windows to be \$640.00 each; the Choir, Transepts, and all other glass to be figured at \$20.00 per sq. ft.

Would suggest that the first window on east side be much lighter in tone than the window now in place on the west side. The east side window will then determine the general tone color for all other windows.

Payments to be made as work progresses and instalation is completed.
