face the altar coming into the Church.
Here St Scholastica in a Brilliant
Setting with a white dove in her
hand, she is generally pictured that
way. Here St. Benedict with a
Staff or Crozier in his hand. he is
pictured that way, with a scroll
or letter in his hand with the Latin
words "ora et labora".

These two Saints are Benedictine
Saints, one the Founder of the Bene-
dictine Order of men. & St. Scholastica
the Foundress of Order of Women. They
are brother & sister & would most
appropriately fit in our Church.
