The windows all arrived the first part of this week and they have now been put in place. ~~In~~ The re-actions that have thus far come, have all been quite favorable. The light from the other windows are such as to prevent the two clearstory windows from showing up to the best advantage, but we are now completing the work of stippling these windows and they are beginning to show up to better advantage. The two side aisle windows are very wonderful and the shadows of the side aisle arches make them very pretty.

I think it will not be necessary for you to come down until you have shipped the other windows and they are ready to be put in place. I wonder how long it will be before you have these ready? We have not yet been able to open the new church and we have now set the date of opening as March 9th. There have been some delays, particularly in the painting of the interior walls. I wish that you could be present for the opening Sunday, but perhaps it will be better for you to come after you have shipped the other windows.

I have heard no note of disappointment of the work that you have already done, but as you say, these two clearstory windows fail to give very much of an impression as to what the whole scene will be.
