I am happy to know that the work turned out so successful, and that we have real art windows. I congratulate you on the fine workmanship, and the pains you took in trying to give us the finest; you will be pleased to hear that we are delighted with the work and quite proud of it.

Mr. Perry was here last week, but left before the last window was finished, so he did not see the church after the work was completed. I suppose we can be expecting you some time in the near future to inspect the windows, now that they are all installed.
