

German formular lettersheets for prisoners of war, printed on special paper that prevented the use of invisible inks, included attached self-addressed postage-free reply pages. The reply portion of this January 6, 1945, letter from a Polish officer in Oflag VIB at Dössel, Germany, to Tarnów, Poland, is still attached and unused. In all probability the sender had been released by the time his letter reached the recipient.
