

Undercover Address Rua Alexandre Herculans 41, Lisbon

Rua Alexandre Herculans 41, Lisbon, Portugal, was an undercover address used by Polish Red Cross headquarters in London, which also served as cover for coded clandestine communication with the Polish Navy in Exile.

An August 3, 1943, registered postal card from Tarnobrzeg, Poland, to the Rua Alexandre Herculans 41, Lisbon, undercover address, censored at Munich. On the back is a circular August 14 Lisbon Central arrival registry datestamp.
