

Victory in Europe: Germany Surrenders to the Allies

Germany surrendered to the victorious Allies on May 8, 1945. The last European city to be liberated from the Nazis was Prague, Czechoslovakia, on May 12.

With no stamps available on May 16, 1945, postage for this registered letter was paid in cash at Prague. The German spelling, "Prag," was obliterated from the registry label.
