

Undercover Address Rua do Arsenal, 100, Lisbon

Rua do Arsenal, 100, Lisbon, Portugal, was an undercover address used by a Polish relief agency, which may also have served as cover for communication with resistance groups.

The brief message on this April 25, 1942, postal card from Bochnia, Poland, to the Rua do Arsenal, 100, Lisbon, undercover address acknowledged receipt of a food shipment, but must have aroused a censor's suspicion. A streak on the back shows where a chemical was applied to check for secret writing with invisible ink.
