My husband does not want come back to Poland. He loves life in the US. We promised ourself to be together until the end of life. I do not want to be illegally in the US anymore. I also love life in US. I like very friendly and polite people here, who are smiling at me even if they do not know me, they are very tolerant also. I do not like what is happening today in Poland. Stupidity and the arrogance of politicians is disgusting to me. I don't want to live in a country where people are not respected only because they have different religions or skin color.

I have already mentioned all the reasons for which I would like to receive a Green Card.
