
"I am calling the attention of the pupils of the North Fork Union School to the sale of Defense Stamps, which are available in the principal's office. These stamps are put out by the government, and the money from their sale is to be used for National Defense. They come in two denominations - 10¢ and 25¢, and the books may be obtained from Mr. Thomason or Mrs. Eastman.

When the books are filled they will amount to one Baby Bond, valued at \$18.75. The stamps can be cashed in at any time at the Post Office.

Our president's wife, Mrs. Eisenhower, heads the bond Drive. There is no obligation attached to this drive, and you are free at any time to get further information at the school office. The American Legion Auxiliary hopes that all will become interested".
