

NO EMERGENCY TEACHERS ON REGULAR NORTH FORK STAFF

7 LIFE, 9 REGULAR
AND 2 PROVISIONAL
ON LOCAL STAFF

The 14 regular teachers on the staff of the North Fork Union School hold 18 credentials, none of which are "Emergency" in rank.

The total years of experience of this group of educators is over one hundred and thirty, which is also an excellent record, along with the number of teaching credentials held by the staff.

This group of people is much better prepared to do their work than most groups in rural areas where the percentage of "Emergency" credentials often runs to fifty. "Approximately one out of every eleven certificated persons now serving in California public schools holds an emergency credential", according to a recent survey.


This staff of fourteen persons are graduates of institutions in Ohio, Colorado, California, Arizona, Massachusetts, Kansas, Idaho and Indiana.
