JULIA TYLER
(1820-1889)

Julia Tyler was the second wife of the 10th president, John Tyler (1844-1845). No other president had been married while in office and his marriage to the 24 year old Julia aroused much public interest. She was a Northerner but gave her allegiance to the South. Her loyalty deepened as the feeling between the North and South deepened. She used to have the Marine band play at the White House and introduced "Hail to the Chief" as the presidential theme song. She presided over the White House for 8 months and then they retired to his Virginia plantation, Sherwood Forest.
